## Wild Wind 19564



Wild Wind foaled in 1927 and has given nearly a century's worth of history to the American Saddlebred breed. Sired by Wild Rex by Emmet Chief, and out of Fanny Tucker by King Chieftain, she had Harrison Chief appear three times on her pedigree. She was a full sister to breeding stallion Rex Shannon. With no show record to be found, this mare made her mark through her progeny, and she is without equal. Producing 19 foals in 22 seasons, she was an early recipient of the Broodmare Hall of Fame designation. She is the start of 6 generations of BHF mares that made lasting impacts on the breed. She was purchased by RG Jones of N. Middleton, Kentucky in 1931 and many of her early foals were sired by King's Genius who had been bred by Jones' brother Allie Jones. Sold to Stroop & Gallagher in 1936, she caught the eye of their trainer Earl Teater who would later select some of her offspring as

show horses when he was at Dodge Stables. In 1940, she was sold when Stroop & Gallagher's Bettydot Stables dispersed. She was the high selling horse and went to her last home, James K Robinson's Crebilly Farm in West Chester, Pennsylvania. Her final foal was produced at age 26 and she died the following year at age 27.

Wild Wind appears on the dam line of dozens of great horses, with her daughters and granddaughters carrying on her legacy. CH Local Talent, CH Too Much, WC Karissa Hi Lite, CH Sinatra, WC Yorkshire Pudding BHF, Putting on Airs BHF, Crebilly's Plumb Beautiful BHF and Supreme Fascination BHF all have Wild Wind on the bottom line of their pedigree. So do World's Grand Champions CH Supreme Airs BHF, CH Valerie Emerald, CH Foxfire's Prophet and Marc of Charm. Add in stallions Truly Genius, Chairman of the Board, WC Supreme Heir, Five Point American Rebel, The Kentucky Wildcat, Carouse, Yorktown Magic, Castle Bravo, Deep Blue, Northern Blues, Victory's Redemption, Cedarview's WD York and Reedann's Top Gun, along with the horses they sired, and Wild Wind's impact grows exponentially.
